DIVISIONS

The following divisions and distances will be offered, however due to number of skater entries and time constraints, some divisions WILL race simultaneously.

Each division listed will be awarded separately

World Class Men – Marathon – age 13 & over

World Class Women – Marathon – age 13 & over

Pro Master Men – Marathon – age 35 & over

Pro Master Women – Marathon – age 35 & over

Advanced Men – Marathon – age 13 – 34, 35 – 49, 50 & over

Advanced Women – Marathon – age 13 – 34, 35 – 49, 50 & over

5K Roll Men – age 12 & below, 13 – 34, 35 & over

5K Roll Women – age 12 & below, 13 – 34, 35 & over

Beginner fun roll – 2K – This division is for the recreational skater who has no indoor or outdoor ‘racing’ experience with rollerblades or conventional ‘quad’ skates only (no inline skates). The age groups will be determined on race-day because entries for the Beginner Fun Roll are accepted up to the morning of the race. The cut-off time for entries will be 9:00am.

World Class and Pro Master marathon skaters will compete on the course at the same time (but awarded separately). These skaters will have 1 hour 45 minutes to complete the marathon. Any skater not able to complete the distance in this time will be required to leave the course due to time constraints.

Advanced Marathon skaters will compete on the course at the same time (but awarded separately). These skaters will have 2 hours (about 13 mph average speed) to complete the marathon. Any skater not able to complete the distance in this time will be required to leave the course due to time constraints.

SAFETY INFO

Helmets are MANDATORY for all ages and classifications, **NO EXCEPTIONS** (your safe racing experience is important to us). We **HIGHLY** recommend additional safety equipment be worn by **ALL** skaters, including elbow, wrist and knee guards, and gloves.

Each skater must have a **USARS** membership card **OR** a **USARS** one-day card (included with any entry-no additional charge to the skater).

Each skater skates at their own risk.

A Medical / First Aid area will be available and staffed by **VOLUNTEERS** with First Aid certification through the Red Cross at a minimum.

COURSE

The course will be in the Rancho Cordova Business Park and blocked off to all traffic. It is approximately 2.5 miles, with some left and right turns, and generally flat. It is a road course so asphalt conditions are typical but seem to be clear of significant hazards.
